



## **CMA CGM takes delivery of 'CMA CGM Amerigo Vespucci'**

CMA CGM Group took delivery of their latest vessel 'CMA CGM Amerigo Vespucci' yesterday at Daewoo Shipbuilding and Marine Engineering.

The second of a series of eight vessels named after the great explorers, the vessel is the sister ship of the 'CMA CGM Christophe Colomb'. The 13,830TEU vessels are 365 metres long, 51.2 metres wide and draw 15.5 metres.

'CMA CGM Amerigo Vespucci' sails under the French flag, and is equipped with an electronically controlled engine, double-hull protected bunker tanks, and a Fast Oil Recovery System, which enables bunkers to be rapidly recovered at any time, hence significantly limiting the environmental consequences should there be an incident at sea.

The position of its superstructure, located in the front, maximises space utilisation and improves visibility from the bridge.
