French shipping group Louis Dreyfus Armateurs (LDA) has requested the China Shipbuilding Industry Corporation (CSIC) install Fast Oil Recovery Systems (FORS) in its future bulk carriers.

FORS is a procedure patented by the Bureau Veritas for the rapid recovery of pollutants carried by ships.

The French ship owner has recently signed a contract with CSIC to build eight bulk carriers by Tianjin Xingang Shipbuilding Heavy Industry.

The installation of FORS will raise the level of environmental safety in all eight vessels, which are meant to transport hydrocarbons.

FORS also provide a quick and simple solution for the crew that will reduce the consequences of growing off-specifications bunkering problems.
